Cllr Spires proposed that a budget of $£ 1,000$ be used for drama equipment including lights, curtains and steps. Cllr Oatham seconded this proposal. All in favour.

- Quotes for different areas in the children's playground considered including a new hopscotch. It was then thought that it might be better to renew the whole surface. Clerk to contact Playquip and Jupiter to get a quote. Clerk to find out about new slide in the older play area.
