63 Lawling Park Hall

- Quote for trees A quote to cut back the 2 sycamore trees at the entrance to the Lawling Park was considered. Cllr Spires proposed to accept this quote for £225. Cllr Chandler seconded. All in favour.
- Playground Equipment The results of a poll asking residents about what equipment they would like in the small children's playground was discussed. Seven items were included in the poll with photographs. The large Pirate ship received 70% of the votes; the trampoline received 22% of the votes. Cllr Spires proposed that the quote to install the pirate ship from Playquip Leisure be accepted at a cost of £20,468, the surfacing for £4,134.00 and to extend the existing fencing around the new equipment at a cost of £2,865.00. Funds still remaining in budget to be spent on playground is £28,934.00. Cllr Chandler seconded this. All in favour.
