40 Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Cllr Haywood proposed accepting the minutes from the meeting held on 24th September 2024. Cllr Ayodele seconded this proposal. All in favour.

The Clerk's update on matters from the previous meeting was noted.

43 Lawling Park Hall

- **Football Goals** – Discussion over why goals were left on the field after games. Clerk has spoken to club secretary and been informed low in managers to help remove them.
- **Additional Footpaths** – Cllr Spires proposed that a further quote from DJMoore Landscaping was accepted for the link path between the two fields and the path to the Sona arch. The cost of these additions is £1,000. Cllr Haywood seconded. All in favour. The path to the gym area would be included in the original quote.
- **Keypad** – To discuss at the next meeting
- **Sports Hall** – Discussion over proposal for new sports hall and the costs involved. Cllr Spires proposed that this be included on the next full parish meeting agenda so that all councillors can vote on whether this is viable or not. Cllr Chandler seconded. All in favour.
- **Sensory Garden** – Update from Cllr Haywood on next steps. Electrics to be completed by new electrician.
- **New Energy Contract** - Cllr Spires proposed accepting the renewal notice for supplying electricity to the hall with a 12 month contract with SSE. Cllr Chandler seconded. All in favour.
- **Budget for Lawling Park** - Clerk suggested that budget be kept the same as this current year. All in favour.
